Our Appointment System

You can make an appointment by –

- Filling out an online consultation
- Dialling 01926 293711
- Accessing the NHS App (non GP appts)
- Visiting the surgery in person

You can submit an online consultation form via our website from 8am, Monday-Friday. Patients who cannot do this, can call from 08:30am and one of our reception team will complete this form for you. This will then be triaged by a GP and you will be booked for a call-back/face to face appointment as and when clinically appropriate. This may be the same day or a future appointment if not urgent for on the day care.

Appointments with Nurse Practitioners and Nurses are bookable up to 5-6 weeks in advance.

To obtain **home visits**, which are reserved for those unable to attend the surgery, you are required to call on the day you need a home visit and a GP will call you back and arrange this with you.

To Register

We welcome new patients to register with us. Our practice boundary can be viewed on our website. You can still apply to register with us if you live outside of our catchment area but you will not be eligible for home visits. For this service, please apply in writing to the surgery.

You can apply to be registered with Priory Medical Centre via our website or by collecting the forms from reception.

You will be registered with one of our GP's, but have the right to see any GP in the practice.

We are fully committed to the security of medical records and staff have access only to complete their roles. All information is stored securely and you have the right to see your records which you should discuss with your usual GP.
